The Hong Kong actuarial profession body was formed in 1968 as the Actuarial Association of Hong Kong (AAHK) and, 26 years later, its successor, the Actuarial Society of Hong Kong (ASHK) was duly incorporated in January 1994. The ASHK is a full member of the International Actuarial Association (IAA), which has 63 full member organizations and 22 associate member organizations around the world. The membership of the ASHK is now around 740 with over 420 Fellows fully qualified through examinations by the professional bodies in the U.K., U.S.A., Australia and elsewhere. It is one of the largest such professional body in Asia. The ASHK is governed by an elected Council with a President, an Immediate Past President, a Vice President and 10 Council Members. The ASHK sets certain Professional Standards and Actuarial Guidance Notes for members to follow.
